# ASMA AKTER

## CASE STORY

On 30th July 2022 at around 1 AM in Norshingdi, Asma Akter, 24, and her 18-month-old child Mostakim, were attacked with acid by her husband, Noyon Mia, 25, over dowry.

The acid burnt Asma Akter's face, hand, and the right side of her body and Mostakim's face and head.

They were taken to the nearest hospital at Norshingdi by her parents and then to Sheikh Hasina National Institute of Burn and Plastic Surgery, Dhaka upon referral.

According to her father, he filed a case against Noyon after he pressured Asma for dowry and verbally divorced her. After being released on bail, Noyon threw acid on Asma and his child.

A case has been filed against Noyon at the Madhobdi Police Station. The perpetrator is now in jail.

Asma Akter and her child is currently receiving medical, psychological, legal, and financial support from ASF.
