
Recap

Anowara was attacked with acid in her sleep along with her two daughters on 25 May 2022 over family disputes. The acid burnt her scalp, face, left eye and mouth.

It was Anowara's first time visiting ASF's health center and it turned out to be very memorable. She was impressed by the center's facilities, care and empathetic treatment.
